SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 605, L. D. 807, Bill,
"AN ACT to Revise Laws Relating to Outdoor Advertising."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting at the end of that part designated subsection 6 the following underlined sentence: 'Such advertisements and structures advertising a business or profession located substantially below the level of nearby highways shall not be limited in such a way so as to be obscured from the vision of motorists traveling said highways.'
