SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 605, L. D. 807, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Revise Laws Relating to Outdoor Advertising."


Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 6 of section  
2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'6. Height. The maximum height of on-premise advertisements shall  
be 25 feet above the ground level of land upon which it is located or if  
the sign is affixed to or is part of a building, the maximum is 10 feet  
above the roof of the building.'
