SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 606, L. D. 808, Bill,
"AN ACT Reclassifying the Waters of Lake Auburn and Little
Wilson Pond, Androscoggin County."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the word
"Pond" and before the comma the words 'and Taylor Brook'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 368, sub-§ 21, amended. Sub-
section 21 of that part of section 368 of Title 38 of the
Revised Statutes which is captioned "Androscoggin River Basin -
Little Androscoggin River Drainage," as amended, is further
amended to read as follows:

21. Taylor Brook (Auburn) --- Class B-2 B-1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line after the enacting clause the abbreviation and figure
'Sec. 2.'
