AN ACT Increasing Payments to Oxford County Law Library.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 27, § 224, amended. The 10th paragraph of section 224 of Title 27 of the Revised Statutes, which relates to Oxford County, is amended to read as follows:

Oxford, ~~\$4,500~~ \$8,600 for the year 1971, of which ~~\$2,250~~ \$3,100 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at South Paris and ~~\$2,250~~ \$5,500 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at Rumford and \$6,000 thereafter, of which \$3,000 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at South Paris and \$3,000 shall be for the use and benefit of the county law library at Rumford,

STATEMENT OF FACT

Due to prior increases in the costs of law books, it is necessary to provide additional funds; there have been no increases in the stipend for the Oxford County Law Library for 10 years while the costs of books have increased many times.
