AN ACT Increasing Salary of Sheriff of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 4th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, which relates to the salary of the sheriff of Cumberland County, is further amended to read as follows:

sheriff, ~~\$8,800~~ \$10,000;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salary of the sheriff in the most populated county to equal that of chiefs of police in smaller municipalities and that of captain in the larger ones.

The sheriff of Cumberland County does not receive any subsistence nor any stipends other than his salary.
