STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statues, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Aroostook County: County commissioners, \$1,500 \$2,000, except that one member of the board, designated by the board as chief administrative officer, shall receive \$5,500 \$7,500; clerk of courts, \$6,000 \$8,500; county attorney, \$8,500 \$10,500; assistant county attorney, \$5,500 \$7,500; county treasurer, \$3,500; sheriff, \$6,500 \$8,500; register of deeds, northern district, \$5,500 \$7,000; southern district, \$5,500 \$7,000; judge of probate, \$4,500 for the year 1971 and \$5,500 for the year 1972.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of the Attorney General the sum of \$10,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1971.
