**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Ida M. Reiss of Andover for Well Damage
Resulting from Highway Construction.**

Ida M. Reiss, reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund to Ida M. Reiss, of Andover, the sum of \$1,500 for damage to her well as a result of reconstruction of Route 5 in 1964.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Route 5 in Andover was reconstructed in 1964 causing damage to Mrs. Reiss' well, located approximately 300 feet from her home.
