STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement to Certain Municipalities for Winter Maintenance of State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 23, § 1005, sub-§ 1, ¶ D, additional. Subsection 1 of section 1005 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 490 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding a new paragraph D to read as follows:
 - D. If the state valuation is more than \$750,000 but does not exceed \$1,000,000, the municipality shall bear the first \$70 of the cost per mile and reimbursement shall be made to said municipalities in accordance with payrolls as submitted and approved; except that such reimbursement shall not exceed \$200 per mile.

FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost to the General Highway Fund would amount to approximately \$75,000 per year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The proposed legislation would ease the financial burden of several towns whose valuation has exceeded \$750,000.
