SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 619, L. D. 830, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Steel Guardrails on the Maine Turnpike."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the words
"Steel Guardrails" and inserting in place thereof the words
'Safety Barriers'


Further amend said Bill by striking out everything before
the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Maine Turnpike; safety barriers. The Maine Turnpike
Authority shall erect and maintain safety barriers in the center
of the median strip on the turnpike from York to Augusta. Such
safety barriers shall be erected by December 31, 1974.'

safety barriers and to set a time by which the safety barriers
shall be erected.
