SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 619, L. D. 830, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Steel Guardrails on the Maine Trunpike."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Sec. 2. Application. If, prior to the effective date of this Act, the Maine Turnpike is transferred to the State of Maine, such safety barriers shall be erected by the State Highway Commission within a time limit established by the Governor.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that if the Maine Turnpike is transferred to the State the safety barriers will be constructed by the State Highway Commission.
