IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Steel Guardrails on the Maine Turnpike.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine Turnpike; guardrails. The Maine Turnpike Authority shall erect and maintain steel guardrails in the median strip on the turnpike from Kittery to Augusta.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to protect motorists traveling on the Maine Turnpike.
