

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 476, L. D. 837, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Colt Stake Program for Maine Standard Bred Horses."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end before the period in that part designated "<u>§ 281.</u>" of section 1 the underlined punctuation and words ', after due notice and hearing'

Further amend said Bill in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) in that part designated " $\underline{S}$  62-A." of section 2 by striking out the underlined words "equal to the purse" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words and punctuation 'to match the contribution towards the purse, except for fees made by the licensee'

Further amend said Bill in the 8th line (7th in L.D.) in that part designated "<u>§62-A.</u>" of section 2 by striking out the underlined figure "<u>\$1,000</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '\$2,000'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "<u>§ 62-A.</u>" of section 2 by inserting at the end the following: 'Nomination, starting and stallion fees shall be determined by the commission. Nomination fees shall be kept separate for pacers and trotters and shall be paid in equal amounts to all licensees participating in this program. These fees shall be paid directly to the licensee and shall also be added to the purses paid under this program. Stallion fees shall be used for promotion of this program under the direction of the commission. The commission may make all rules and regulations necessary to carry out this program after due notice and public hearing.'
