**AN ACT to Appropriate Funds for Payment to Veterinarians for Vaccinating
against Brucellosis.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Industry, the sum of \$40,000 to resume paying practicing veterinarians for vaccinating calves against brucellosis. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

A reduction in the allotment from the appropriation for this purpose made it necessary to discontinue paying practicing veterinarians for vaccinating calves against brucellosis.
