IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Jury Commissioners of York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 14, § 1252, amended. The first paragraph of section 1252 of Title 14 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 3 of chapter 414 of the public laws of 1967 and by section 3 of chapter 441 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

The jury commissioners for the several counties shall each receive for their services the following sums per year, and expenses: Androscoggin, \$175; Aroostook, \$125; Cumberland, \$275; Franklin, \$100; Hancock, \$100; Kennebec, \$125; Knox, \$100; Lincoln, \$100; Oxford, \$100; Penobscot, \$125; Piscataquis, \$75; Sagadahoc, \$100; Somerset, \$100; Waldo, \$100; Washington, \$100; York, \$200 \$400.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of the jury commissioners of York County from \$200 to \$400 per year.
