STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of County Officers of Waldo County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2 amended. The 15th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Waldo County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Waldo County: County commissioners, \$1,200 \$1,400; clerk of courts, \$5,700 \$6,300; county attorney, \$8,000; county treasurer, \$1,900 \$2,100; sheriff, \$5,800 \$6,400; register of deeds, \$5,000 \$5,500; judge of probate, \$5,000 \$5,500; register of probate, \$5,000 \$5,500.

Sec. 2. Application. Salary increases provided in this Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1971.
