COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 298, L. D. 855, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Use of Electronic Recording Equipment in the
District Court and before Administrative Agencies."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out after the word
"Court" before the period the words "and before Administrative
Agencies"

Further amend said Bill in the 4th, 5th and 6th lines after
the amending clause (4th and 5th in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined words "or any administrative agency and the taking of
depositions relating to any judicial proceeding to be"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to delete the portion of the
bill relating to administrative agencies and taking of depositions.
