COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 276, L. D. 859, Bill, "AN ACT Clarifying the Secondary School Tuition Law."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the first underlined sentence in section 29 the following:

'At the close of the school year and no later than July 1st, the school committee, board of directors or board of trustees shall cause to be computed the actual per pupil cost expended in the operation of the secondary school program for the year just completed. In the event that the school tuition charge exceeded the actual per pupil cost, each sending administrative unit shall be reimbursed the amount of the tuition overcharge, or such a sum shall be credited to the next tuition bill of the sending administrative unit.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that schools or municipalities cannot charge more than their actual costs.
