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**AN ACT** Relating to Legislative Service under the State Retirement System.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1123, amended.** Section 1123 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 206 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding at the end the following 2 paragraphs:

Any person who is a recipient of a state retirement allowance may upon completion of 10 years in the Legislature as a legislator have the creditable service in the Legislature added to his retirement allowance and a recomputation of his retirement allowance made at the completion of his legislative service.

Said member shall make contributions on all salaries earned during said legislative service and the computation for the additional benefits shall be based strictly upon the legislative salaries.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment would enable a retired member who after retirement, becomes a legislator to have his service as a legislator included in as service to increase his retirement allowance.
