AN ACT Relating to Approval of Schools Enrolling Nonresident Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 102, sub-§ 17, additional. Section 102 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 17 to read as follows:

17. Approval of schools. All schools enrolling nonresident pupils shall be subject to an annual review of its program and shall be approved on an annual basis by the commissioner when it meets standards equivalent to those required of public and private schools enrolling both resident and nonresident pupils.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to establish basic standards for all schools operating in Maine whether they enroll resident or nonresident pupils.
