IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to a Minimum Salary for Full-time Municipal Law Enforcement Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2401, sub-§ 2, additional. Section 2401 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 2, to read as follows:

2. Salary. Each municipality shall pay an annual salary of not less than \$6,200 to each full-time law enforcement officer in its employ.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is to establish a minimum pay level for all law enforcement officers.
