STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Hermon for Support Rendered an Unsettled State Welfare Case.

Town of Hermon; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$530.71 to reimburse the Town of Hermon for welfare assistance rendered to an applicant who was subsequently determined to be an unsettled state charge.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The town of Hermon paid out the sum of \$530.71 in temporary assistance for the family of a Mr. Carleton Henderson who was residing in Hermon at the time. Subsequently, the state settlement worker ascertained that Mr. Henderson was unsettled and, therefore, a state charge. However, due to the lapse of time and a lack of funds in the Health and Welfare Department, they have not yet reimbursed the town of Hermon.
