**AN ACT to Organize a Division of Housing within the Environmental
Improvement Commission.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 38, § 361, amended. Section 361 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

The commission shall organize a Division of Housing which shall be authorized and empowered to promulgate such rules and regulations to assist, coordinate and expedite the processing of any application, permit or license issued by any state agency which is prerequisite to gaining final determination or approval of the commission.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this legislation to provide a Division of Housing within the Environmental Improvement Commission to expedite the application process among the various state agencies concerned so that a developer need only apply to said commission to gain clearance from the State.
