AN ACT Establishing Clerks of Courts and Registers of Probate as Full Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 551, amended. Section 551 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as last repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 229 of the public laws of 1969, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Each clerk of courts shall devote full time to his duties.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 18, § 251, amended. Section 251 of Title 18 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by inserting after the first paragraph the following new paragraph:

Each register of probate shall devote full time to his duties.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to make the positions of clerk of courts and register of probate full time.
