STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers and Duties of School Principals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 20, § 163, additional. Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 163 to read as follows:
- § 163. Powers and duties of principals
- 1. Supervision of teachers. He shall direct and supervise the work of all teachers.
- 2. Report. He shall make a written report 4 times a school year on each teacher which shall include the following:
 - A. Proficiency of students;
 - B. Methods of teaching;
 - C. Methods of discipline;
 - D. Rapport with students.

These reports shall be sent to the superintendent.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to more definitely set forth the duties of school principals as they relate to teachers.
