AN ACT Relating to the Transportation of Students to Technical and Vocational Centers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 2356-C, amended. Section 2356-C of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 3 of chapter 440 of the public laws of 1965 and as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Any administrative unit which pays tuition to a regional technical and vocational center shall furnish transportation for its students to and from such a center or pay board in lieu thereof. The cost of such transportation shall be subsidized under the regular general purpose aid formula.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to require transportation to and from regional vocational and technical schools. Each unit would be subsidized at the same rate as for transportation of children locally.
