STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Teachers' Conventions and Reimbursements for Professional Credits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, c. 201, repealed. Chapter 201 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 20, § 1902, amended. The first paragraph of section 1902 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 177 of the public laws of 1967, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to remove obsolete language from the statutes relating to teachers' conventions and to require that such conventions be held at times which would not interfere with the normal operation of the school program.

The paragraph relating to professional credits was adopted when the State directly contributed to the teachers' expenditure for professional improvement and should be eliminated as the State no longer directly subsidizes such programs.
