## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition by Administrative Units Not Maintaining an Approved Secondary School.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 1291, amended. Section 1291 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, in cases where a pupil does not during the school year reside in the administrative unit which does not mantain an approved secondary school, tuition shall be paid by such administrative unit and such tuition shall not exceed the average cost per pupil in all secondary schools of the State of that type. Any tuition in excess of such average cost per pupil shall be paid by the parent or legal guardian of such pupil.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the tuition payments of administrative units which do not maintain an approved secondary school.
