COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 673, L. D. 910, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Black Bass Fishing in Lakes, Ponds and Rivers."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the **S**tatement of Fact, the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 12, §2552, sub-§4, repealed. Subsection 4 of section 2552 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is repealed as follows:

<u>4</u>--All-fish-except-black-bass-in-brooks-and-streams---There shall-be-an-open-season-for-all-fish-except-black-bass-in-brooks and-streams-in-waters-free-of-ice-from-April-1st-to-August-15th7 except-in-Aroostook-County-the-open-season-shall-be-from-May-1st to-August-15th-'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal Title 12, section 2552, subsection 4 to prevent confusion in the original bill.
