**AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Continue Housing Services for Older
People.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Department of Health and Welfare; appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund the sum of \$13,520 to provide for continuation of its services for housing services for older people by establishing resource staff in housing for the elderly. These housing specialists will work to make residential units such as private housing, nonprofit housing, low-moderate income housing, and public housing more available at the lowest feasible cost to lower income citizens of Maine. The staff will work for the construction of new and improvement of existing structures. The breakdown of expenditures shall be as follows:
