STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Designating Public Accountants as Licensed Public Accountants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 32, § 3984, amended. Section 3984 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 344 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

§ 3984. Certificate

Any person who shall have received from the board a certificate of his qualifications to practice as a public accountant, as provided in sections 3985 and 3986, shall be styled and known as a licensed public accountant, and no other persons shall assume such title or any other words, letters or figures to indicate that the person using the same is such a public accountant.

Sec. 2. Application. Wherever in the Revised Statutes and in the public laws the words "public accountant" appear they shall mean "licensed public accountant."

STATEMENT OF FACT

This is to preclude discrimination in the accounting field and to conform with similar nomenclature in other states.
