HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 682, L. D. 919, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Forestry Cutting Practices for the Protection
of Rivers, Streams and Lakes."

Amend said Bill in the 8th line of the 3rd paragraph of
that part designated "§ 519." (7th line in L.D.) by inserting
after the underlined word "Commission" the underlined words
'or his alternate'

Further amend said Bill in the first line of subsection 2
of that part designated "§ 519." by striking out the underlined
words "foresters. Foresters" and inserting in place thereof the
underlined words 'Forestry Department personnel. Forestry
Department personnel'

Improvement Commission and
2. Change "foresters" to "Forestry Department personnel"
