HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 682, L. D. 919, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Forestry Cutting Practices for the Protection of Rivers, Streams and Lakes."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after that part designated "§519." the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Forestry Department the sum of \$281,650 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
