HOUSE AMENDMENT "C " to H. P. 682, L. D. 919, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Forestry Cutting Practices for the Protection of
Rivers, Streams and Lakes."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§519." by striking
out all of subsection 5 and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'5. Jurisdiction. The commissioner shall have jurisdiction
over all forests within the unorganized territories of the State.'

The purpose of this amendment is to restrict jurisdiction
of this bill to unorganized territories.
