STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Payment of Life Insurance Premiums of State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 1151, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1151 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 189 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the State shall pay the premium for the first \$5,000 of the total amount of basic group life insurance to which each appointive officer or employee of the State of Maine is eligible, except that the State shall not pay the premium for any appointive officer or employee of the State who has signified his desire not to be insured, as provided in subsection 4.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine State Retirement System the sum of \$140,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972, and the sum of \$150,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will allow state employees a life insurance premium fringe benefit which is available to many employees in private industry and to the employees of some of Maine's sister states.
