IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes which relates to Kennebec County, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Kennebec County: County commissioners, \$2,750 \$3,500; chairman, \$3,000 \$4,000; clerk of courts, \$5,775 \$6,275; deputy clerk of courts, \$4,395 \$4,835; county attorney, \$9,000; assistant county attorney, \$6,000; county treasurer, \$4,500 \$5,000; sheriff, \$7,000 \$7,500; register of deeds, \$6,500 \$7,000; judge of probate, \$7,000 \$7,500; register of probate, \$4,500 \$5,000.
