COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 704, L. D. 947, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Subsidy Payments on Expenditures Made
for the Education of Handicapped Children"

Amend said Bill in the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th
lines (5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th lines in L.D.) after
the amending clause by striking out the underlined words and
punctuation "Expenditures for special education pupils in
classes operated by the unit or for pupils tuitioned to other
schools when such expenditures have been approved by the
commissioner shall be subsidized in accordance with Table I.
Only those expenditures which exceed the reimbursement under
the equalization formula shall be eligible for the special
subsidy."

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the first line
of the 2nd paragraph after the amending clause (same in L.D)
the underlined words "special education pupils" and inserting
in place thereof the underlined words 'handicapped children'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to provide that a town
will collect its regular subsidy which would include the
handicapped children.
