HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 714, L. D. 959, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Acquisition of Land by Conservation Commissions."

Amend said Bill in the last line before the Statement of Fact (last 2 lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and punctuation "consent of the municipal officers." and inserting in place thereof the underlined words and punctuation 'approval of the legislative body.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment would allow the legislative body of a town to give their consent before a conservation commission of that town could acquire or receive a parcel of land in the town's name.
