STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for Purchase of Fifty Copies Each of History of the District of Maine, Survey of the State of Maine and Tidewater Ice of the Kennebec.

Maine State Museum publications; purchase of copies. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,600 to purchase 50 copies each of Sullivan, History of the District of Maine; Greenleaf, Survey of the State of Maine; and Everson, Tidewater Ice of the Kennebec, all publications of the Maine State Museum; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Legislature has made it possible for the Maine State Library to distribute copies of Maine histories to public libraries throughout the State free of charge. The program has enabled smaller libraries in the State, with limited book funds, to obtain copies of these volumes for research.
