COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 334, L. D. 980, Bill,

"AN ACT Providing for Double Compensation for Injuries to Minors

under Workmen's Compensation Law if Employment in Violation of Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th line (same in L. D.) the underlined word "Compensation" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'When an employer has failed to take reasonable precaution to ascertain the age of the employee, compensation'
