IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor at Golf Courses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 2, sub-§ 16, amended. The first sentence of the 2nd paragraph of subsection 16 of section 2 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 363 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Without limitation of its other powers, the commission shall not approve as a proper place for the exercise of the license privilege, amusement areas primarily for minors, golf courses beaches or any other area designed primarily for use by minors.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This will permit the sale of liquor at golf courses when all other requirements of the liquor laws are met.
