STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Full-time Deputy Sheriffs and Chief Deputies of Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 958, amended. The last sentence of section 958 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Such full-time deputy sheriffs shall not receive more than \$112 and chief deputies shall not receive more than \$119 in the aggregate for any one week, except that these limitations shall not apply to Androscoggin County, Cumberland County, Penobscot County and York County.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove full-time and chief deputy sheriffs of Penobscot County from the statutory limits for their compensations.
