SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to S. P. 398, L. D. 1011, Bill, "AN ACT Limiting the Amount of Money Spent by Candidates Seeking Political Office."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first 3 lines after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 21, §1395, sub-§§3-10, additional. Section 1395 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding 8 new subsections to be numbered 3 to 10, to read as follows:'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined word "advertising" in the 6th line (Same in L. D.) the underlined punctuation and words ', as described in section 1575,'

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 14th and 15th lines (13th line of L. D.) the underlined words "or other services" and inserting in place thereof the underlined punctuation and words ', as described in section 1575,'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following:

'10. Written political advertisement. Every written political advertisement published and distributed as a flyer, handbill or other nonperiodical publication shall state thereon the name of the print shop, printer or person printing, mimeographing or otherwise publishing the advertisement.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to clarify subsections 3 and 4 by inserting references to section 1575 and to require that any handbill or flyer carry the name of the printer or otherwise publishing the advertisement.
