SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 398, L. D. 1011, Bill, "AN ACT Limiting the Amount of Money Spent by Candidates Seeking Political Office."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the last 2 lines of subsection 3 (same in L. D.) the underlined words "whichever amount is the greater" and inserting in place thereof the following 'except in case of United States Senators and Governor, which amount shall be doubled'

Statement of Fact
