SENATE AMENDMENT " C " to S. P. 398, L. D. 1011, Bill,
"AN ACT Limiting the Amount of Money Spent by Candidates Seeking
Political Office."

Amend said Bill in the last line of subsection 3 (same
in L.D.) by inserting before the period the following: 'except
that a candidate for Governor and United States Senator shall
be allowed to dispense twice the amount provided in this
subsection'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exclude U. S. Senators
and Governor to the extent of a doubled amount due to the area
covered.
