COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 341, L.D. 1012, Bill, "AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Drug Abuse."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 2. Interagency Commission on Drug Abuse; appropriation.
There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 to the Department of Mental Health and Corrections, Interagency Commission on Drug Abuse to provide funds for grants to assist local drug abuse programs and any balance of this account as of June 30, 1972 shall carry forward for the same purposes until June 30, 1973.

Sec. 3. Matching Funds-Federal Drug Education; appropriation.
There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 for the year ending June 30, 1972 and the sum of \$30,000 for the year ending June 30, 1973 to the Department of Education, Matching Funds-Federal Drug Education to provide funds for state participation for a drug education program.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide moneys to the
