STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Continuing the Maine Cultural Building Authority.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Cultural Building, so called, will be completed this spring: and

Whereas, the Maine Cultural Building Authority may pass out of existence upon completion of the building; and

Whereas, the Authority should continue in existence for at least a year following the completion of the Cultural Building, so called; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maine Cultural Building Authority continued. The Maine Cultural Building Authority as created by Private and Special Law, 1965, chapter 259 and constituted by appointment as provided by said law is continued through December 31, 1972 for the purpose of completing its duties and settling any construction problems which may arise after the acceptance of the Cultural Building, so called, as being completed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The Maine Cultural Building Authority's existence terminates when its duties prescribed by the Act creating it have been performed. This date would be most indeterminate. This Act will set a positive date.
