COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 352, L. D. 1018, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Penal and Correctional
Institution Personnel."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting at the end of
the last line of paragraph E the following underlined sentence:

'Every member who is eligible for the benefits set forth in this
paragraph, shall, effective as of January 1, 1972, make a 7 1/2%
contribution of earnable compensation to the retirement system
as long as he is employed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require the members
involved to assist in financing the proposed changes in benefits.
