SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 352, L. D. 1018, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Retirement of Penal and Correctional
Institution Personnel."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 4th and 5th lines
of section 2 (same in L.D.) the underlined words and punctuation
"the warden or superintendent, duputy warden or assistant
superintendent of a penal or correctional institution, any" and
inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'an'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line of section 2
(same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "such"
and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'penal or
correctional'

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd line of section 3 (2nd in L.D.) by
striking out the figure "\$170,542" and inserting in place
thereof the figure '\$66,000'; and in the last line before the
Statement of Fact by striking out the figure "\$85,271" (2 times)
and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$33,000' (2 times).

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to eliminate from the bill
the warden or superintendent, deputy warden or assistant
superintendent of the penal or correctional institutions.
