HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 753, L. D. 1022, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Bridge across the Kennebec River between the Municipalities of Waterville and Winslow."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 6 the following sentence:

'The tolls shall not be removed except by vote of the people by referendum.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph of the Referendum and inserting in place thereof the following:

"Shall a bond issue be ratified in an amount not to exceed \$3,400,000 to construct a toll bridge across the Kennebec River between the municipalities of Waterville and Winslow and provided that the tolls shall not be removed except by vote of the people by referendum?"

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the tolls shall not be removed except by vote of the people by referendum.
