STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal the Prohibition against Combined Licensing under the Maine Insurance Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 24-A, § 1806, repealed. Section 1806 of Title 24-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would permit a licensed insurance agent or broker to be licensed as an insurance consultant.
